Wednesday September 11

8:30am **Depart Rome** – Freedom Plaza, 205 Erie Blvd.

9:00am **Depart Utica** – In front of parking garage next to Delta Hotel
- ***break stop*** en route

Travel into the beautiful Adirondack Mountains and the High Peaks Region today on a leisurely, scenic drive.

We'll tour the **John Brown Farm State Historic Site**. This is the home and gravesite of the abolitionist who died in the pursuit of freedom of slaves. After an assault on Harpers Ferry to obtain arms in 1859 Brown was hanged in Virginia. His body was transported back to his North Elba home where he is buried.

This afternoon we'll check in to **Hotel North Woods** – 2520 Main Street, Lake Placid. (518) 523-1818. You won't find a more centrally located hotel. There is free wi-fi in the hotel and rooms have a small refrigerator and microwave, and a coffee maker. Delta Blue restaurant is on site and numerous other restaurants are along Main Street.

You'll find shops, a movie theater, wine tasting – all on Main Street just out your door. Mirror Lake is across the street and if you like to walk, you'll love the brick walkway that circles the lake, 2.7 miles. In addition to lake views you'll see some beautiful homes! It's a lovely stroll anytime of day but an especially nice way to start your morning if you choose!

The shops feature everything from art, clothing, hats, souvenirs and Olympic merchandise stores. You are on your own to explore and have dinner. There are so many choices you may find it hard to decide. And if you prefer not to stray too far, the Delta Blue is only an elevator ride away, it's casual and welcoming with a southern theme menu and pub fare. Tonight there will be live entertainment with Open Mic Blues Jam.

Thursday September 12

Breakfast included at hotel.

A local **guide** will join us for a sightseeing tour of the area to include views or stops at many of the **Olympic sites** like the Horse Show grounds where the Olympic Flame Cauldron sits, the ski jumps, the skating oval, Olympic Training Center, and admission to the Winter Olympics Museum. The tour will end at the Museum and then you have free time to continue exploring the area at your leisure. Be sure to have lunch before we depart for home or pick up something to-go! Options for stops on the way home are limited.
