## **VIRGINIA BEACH**

### **Featuring A Musical Celebration of America**

Join us for time at the beach and The International Tattoo, this year a salute to 250 years of American Independence! Join a cast of over 800 performers from across the globe as they take the stage in a dazzling display of military pageantry, precision, and passion, featuring massed pipes and drums, military bands, drill teams, dancers, choirs, and special guests.

#### **Monday, April 13**

Our deluxe motorcoach will depart from Hale Bus Garage in Clinton where you can leave your vehicle parked for the week. Appropriate break stops will be made.

This afternoon check into the **Holiday Inn Express** in Rehoboth Beach, DE for one night. (no luggage handling) Dinner is on your own with options within walking distance of the hotel.

#### **Tuesday, April 14**

A full **breakfast buffet** is included at the hotel before we check-out and depart for Virginia Beach. We'll arrive there in time for a late lunch on own at the Virginia Beach Oceanfront. This afternoon visit the **Military Aviation Museum** to see one of the world's most expansive collections of operational vintage military aircraft. Later, check into the **Courtyard Virginia Beach Oceanfront Hotel** on Atlantic Avenue for three nights. This property is within walking distance to restaurants and nightlife, and features an indoor pool, 24-hour fitness center, onsite restaurant, WiFi, private balconies, and mini frig in each room. NOTE: Room options are one king bed, or two double beds (no queens). A **group dinner** is included at **Captain George's** with an all-you-can-eat buffet and fresh seafood.

#### **Wednesday, April 15**

Enjoy **breakfast** included at the hotel and free time this morning to relax at the oceanfront. Later we'll visit nearby Norfolk for a variety of attractions starting with a **Tram Tour** at **Norfolk Botanical Gardens**. Do some souvenir shopping and have lunch on your own downtown.

This afternoon at **Nauticus** explore interactive exhibits that tell the history of the maritime industry and step aboard the **Battleship Wisconsin**, one of the largest and last battleships ever built by the U.S. Navy. Enjoy a **two-hour Victory Rover Naval Base Cruise** on the smooth waters of the Elizabeth River. This is a great way to see one of the world's busiest seaports including the world's largest naval base, home of the Atlantic Fleet made up of destroyers, guided missile cruisers, submarines, aircraft carriers and more. Tonight's included **dinner is at Town Point Club** in Norfolk.

### **Thursday, April 16**

**Breakfast included** at the hotel and time to explore the Oceanfront. Return to Norfolk today and have a group **luncheon at Fishin' Pig BBQ**. Save room because after lunch there's a special treat at **Doumar's ice cream!** This evening is all about the **Virginia International Tattoo** and related events. **Hullabaloo** festivities begin with music, dancing, drill routines, and drumming exhibitions. The **NATO flag raising ceremony** is at 5pm. There are many food and drink options for dinner on own, as well as souvenir stands! The Tattoo gets underway at 7:30pm. This is more than a show, it's an unforgettable experience and a once-in-a-generation celebration that blends history, heroism, and breathtaking spectacle. Expect heart-stirring moments of majesty and might and timeless traditions.

### **Friday, April 17**

A final **breakfast included** before we check out and start the journey toward home. Tonight's accommodations are at the **Mendenhall Inn** in Chadds Ford, Pennsylvania. (no luggage handling) Dinner on own.

### **Saturday, April 18**

A **breakfast buffet** is included before check-out. We'll visit **Winterthur Museum & Gardens**. This Brandywine Valley landmark was once the home of Henry Francis du Pont. Tour the magnificent 175-room house, and see the premier collection of American decorative arts, with nearly 90,000 objects made or used in America since 1640! Take a 30-minute **tram** through the gardens, and be sure to view the Campbell collection of soup tureens. Arrive in Clinton tonight filled with American pride and wonderful memories.
